Ridgway. We'll have beverage stations, food trucks and the event is **free to attend** -- *though tips for musicians are highly encouraged.*



EXPERIENCE

Fete De La Musique is presented by Weehawken Creative Arts, Sherbino and Citizen's State Bank with support from many others.

On **JUNE 29, 2025** (in honor of the Summer Solstice and World Music Day on June 21st) we will gather the community to play and enjoy music outside in public spaces. Like we did in previous years, our plan is for **MANY MANY** musicians from all genres and levels to participate in this event.

The event is FREE to the public and outdoors, with multiple performances happening simultaneously all over the north side of Ridgway. In 2024, we featured over 17 different performing groups – it's a great time! This year, we will again be closing some streets for safety and featuring food trucks and beverage (adult and NA) concessions.

The event will run outdoors from 4:00pm - dusk and will run along Clinton St., Cora St., the rear of 610 Arts Gallery--The Courtyard, and all the way into Hartwell Park! We POSSIBLY will have a late night show inside the Sherbino as well, but this will be determined closer to the event. *We ask that food vendors stay open until 8 pm, but we welcome you to remain open up until 9:15 if you wish.*

The public will be encouraged to **WALK** to the event and bring additional cash buy food and drink – and to tip the artists and consider donating to support the event.

Just like in past years, we'll get it ALL – Mariachi, harpists, local bands, bluegrass, kids playing drums, electro funk, youth symphony, community chorales and more!
